Overview and objectives

Owning and using land is key to unlocking the economic potential for Liberia and offers possibilities of independent livelihoods for women. This intervention builds lessons learned from a previous intervention – ILAMP project implemented in 2022 with support from Lantmäteriet.

Ensuring equal and fair ownership and use of land in Liberia is dependent on the land authority being functioning and well equipped to work inclusively, handle conflict and being transparent. This will be achieved by increasing and strengthening land services and developing sustainable business processes.

The programme outcomes targeted are:

- Increased availability of land information and services, that also support customary land formalization.
- Improve Liberia Land Authority's institutional capacity to deliver services through sustainable, effective and efficient business processes.
